**DAY SINGAPORE - KILIMANJARO**

**01** Welcome to a unique experience! Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport for your pleasant flight to Tanzania - Kilimanjaro  
Meals on Board

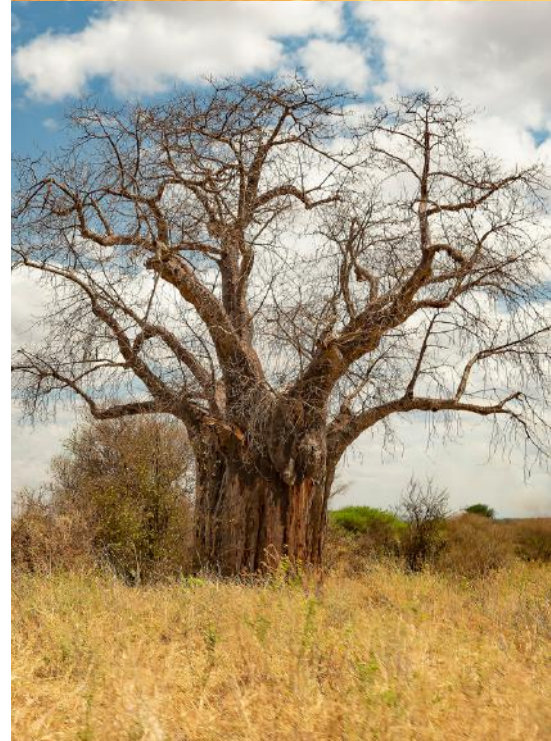
**DAY KILIMANJARO - TARANGIRE  
NATIONAL PARK**

**02** Welcome to Tanzania  
Upon arrival, we will be met by our Tanzania representative.

We will proceed to Tarangire National Park which is one of Tanzania's best-kept secrets. Close to the town of Arusha and hosting Tanzania's highest concentration of elephant population in Africa. It has a horizon dominated by magnificent baobab trees, Legend says that a baobab tree once angered God and was thrown to earth and planted upside down. The trees are known to live for hundreds of year

After lunch, we will proceed to check-in  
In the afternoon, we will leave for our first game drive, Tarangire National Park is an awe-inspiring national park comprising granite ridges, river valleys, mixed vegetative landscapes, and free-roaming wildlife. During the annual dry season, the Tarangire River is a magnet for thirsty wildlife. Large herds of elephants and migratory wildebeest, zebra, buffalo, impala, gazelle, hartebeest, and eland gather and not surprisingly the predators follow. With lion being among the most spotted animal

Return to the lodge for our dinner  
Meals: Lunch, Dinner  
Overnight: Tarangire Sopa Lodge or similar





DAY TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK - NGORONGORO CONSERVATION AREA

**03** This morning, after an early breakfast we will depart for Ngorongoro Conservation Area - which is situated in the Crater Highlands in Northern Tanzania, the Ngorongoro Conservation Area is best known for its archaeological and geological significance, rich wildlife, and beautiful scenery.

The conservation area encompasses the famous Crater, the renowned Olduvai Gorge and vast plains of grasslands, forests and mountains extending to the Serengeti. This 8000-square-kilometre protected area is recognized for its natural beauty and has been placed on the UNESCO World Heritage List.

Descend down to the crater (voted as one of the Seven Natural Wonders of Africa, it is famed for its natural beauty and abundant wildlife) for an afternoon game drive  
After our adventure, we will proceed back to our lodge

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Overnight: Ngorongoro Safari Lodge (Warm jacket/cardigan is highly recommended)



DAY NGORONGORO CONSERVATION AREA

**04** After an early breakfast, we will once again descend some 600 metres into the crater, which is home to an abundance of wildlife and a photogenic paradise for a full day of game-viewing drive

Enjoy a picnic lunch at a scenic site

In the late afternoon, return to the lodge for dinner and the night

Meals: Breakfast, Picnic Box Lunch, Dinner

DAY NGORONGORO CONSERVATION AREA - SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

**05** Enjoy a hearty breakfast at the lodge  
Before we check out, we will pick up our lunches boxes and leave for the world-famous Serengeti Plains

Make a brief stop at the Olduvai Gorge Museum, which exhibits the earliest evidence found in Olduvai Gorge and Laetoli Footprints which holds the earliest evidence of the existence of human ancestors.

Picnic lunch will be served at a convenient location along the way  
After our picnic lunch, we will continue our journey to Serengeti National Park

In the late afternoon, we will go for a game drive in search of the Big Five taking advantage of the heightened activity of the animals in the evenings

The Serengeti National Park is the oldest National Park in Tanzania and has a population of approximately 25,000 large animals, largely ungulates along with reputedly the highest density of mammalian predators in Africa, lives in the crater. Large animals in the crater include the black rhinoceros, hippopotamus, wildebeest, zebra, eland and Thompson's gazelles

Check-in at the camp/lodge for our dinner and the night

Meals: Breakfast, Picnic Box Lunch, Dinner

Overnight: Elewana Serengeti Migration Camp or similar

**DAY SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK**

**06** Enjoy a full day in the Serengeti with morning and afternoon game drives. Millions of plains game – wildebeests, zebra and impala feed and breed in the thousands in readiness for the annual migration north to the Mara ecosystem

Visit the hippo pools where hundreds of big and small lazy hippopotamus soaks and nap in the afternoon sun

Return to the camp for dinner and the night  
Meals: Breakfast, Picnic Lunch, Dinner

**DAY SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK – ISEBANIA  
07 & SIRARI BORDER – MAASAI MARA GAME  
RESERVE (KENYA)**

Enjoy a sumptuous breakfast before heading to Isebania and Sirari. The border town of Kenya and Tanzania

Clear immigration formalities and continue with our journey passing the Mara River as it drains into Lake Victoria and stops at a private scenic site to have your lunch box

Continue again into Maasai Mara National Park which offers wonderful scenery and plenty of games. It is perhaps the only region left in Kenya where you may see animals in the same super-abundance as existed a century ago

Meals: Breakfast, Packed Lunch, Dinner  
Overnight: Elewana Sand River Mara camp or similar

**DAY MAASAI MARA**

**08** Enjoy a full day in Maasai Mara with morning and afternoon game drives in search of the ‘big five’. These include the lion, savannah, elephants, cape buffalo, leopard and the black rhino

The Masai Mara together with Tanzania’s Serengeti form Africa’s most famous wildlife park, the Masai Mara National Reserve. The undeniable highlight of the Masai Mara National Reserve is undoubtedly the annual wildebeest migration traversing the vast plains of the Serengeti and the Masai Mara. It is known as the largest mass movement of land mammals on the planet – with more than a million animals following the rains. Large prides of lions, herds of elephants, as well as giraffes, gazelles and eland can also be spotted in the reserve.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner





**DAY MAASAI MARA**

**09** Enjoy another full day of morning and afternoon game safari and exciting bush adventure.

Visit a traditional Maasai Manyatta (off the beaten track) and experience the culture of this world-famous community. The Maasai people still live as they did for centuries. Interact with these nomadic people and experience their way of life as you learn about their customs and traditions.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

**DAY MAASAI MARA – LAKE ELEMENTEITA**

**10** After breakfast, depart for Lake Elementaita  
Arrive firstly at Lake Nakuru National Park, a bird watcher's paradise on the floor of the Great Rift Valley, surrounded by wooded and bushy grassland.

Enjoy a game drive in Lake Nakuru in search of the black and white rhinos, the endangered Rothschild Giraffe (Twiga), the exclusive leopards as well as a host of other plains game and with a chance to visit the shores of the lake  
Continue to Lake Elementiata for dinner and the night.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Overnight: Elementaita Serena Camp or similar

**DAY LAKE ELEMENTEITA – NAIROBI – SINGAPORE**

**11** After breakfast, bid farewell to the African savannah as we drive to the city of Nairobi where you will have some free time to explore this capital city

Transfer to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport for your homebound flight

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch
