DAY SINGAPORE - DUBROVNIK

01 Assemble at Changi Airport for our flight to Dubrovnik, the pearl of the Adriatic.

DAY DUBROVNIK

02 Embark on a walking tour to discover the 1400 years of Dubrovnik', a UNESCO World Heritage Site rich with hidden gems and beautiful architecture such as Onofrio's Fountain and the Franciscan Monastery.

Stroll on the old city walls, one of the best preserved and most impressive fortresses in the world with spectacular views of the Adriatic Sea.

DAY DUBROVNIK - MOSTAR

03 Drive through the majestic gorge of the River Neretva to Mostar, a beautiful village in Bosnia & Hercegovina.

Admire the most celebrated bridge in the Balkans, Stari Most (old bridge) which was reconstructed after the war. The cobbled old town extends on both sides of the bridge and bustles with trinket sellers.

DAY MOSTAR - SPLIT - ZADAR

04

Split, the second largest city in Croatia and the cultural centre of Dalmatia is not to be missed! Roman Emperor Diocletian's Palace sits in The Inner City with its intriguing maze of cobblestone streets. The Peristyle, located in the eastern part of the palace is considered the most beautiful square in the city.

Enjoy lunch cooked from traditional Dalmatian recipes and ingredients at an ethno village. Explore the village and enjoy some tasting of local produce as well. Zadar is the proud owner of the world-famous Sea Organ, an installation of 35 pipes of various lengths, diameters and slopes. Nearby is the Greeting to the Sun, made of 300 multi-layered glass solar panels in the shape of a circle.

DAY ZADAR - LIKA REGION

Move inland towards the beautiful Plitvice Lakes National Park (UNESCO World Heritage Site). Walk on the wooden promenades to take in the breathtaking scenery of this natural phenomenal marvel of sixteen terraced lakes surrounded by thickly wooded mountains and lush vegetation which are joined in a series of majestic waterfalls and where every turn leads to even more beautiful scenery. (Note: Visit to Krka National Park will be arranged in event of bad weather and closure of Plitvice National Park)

DAY LIKA REGION - ROVINJ - ISTRIA

Travel to Istria, a heart-shaped peninsula often considered Croatia's most amazing region. Be charmed by rolling hills, fertile plains and hilltop villages. Learn all about truffles in this region from a truffle hunting experience in the forest. Savour an explosion of flavours during our truffle lunch.

Continue to the most beloved town, Rovinj, one of the last true Mediterranean fishing ports.

Enjoy the open market where fresh produce from the region is tantalizingly displayed. Stroll through old, cobbled alleys in the old town perched on an elevated peninsula surrounded by Venetian terracotta roofs and crowded by the 18th century Church of St Euphemy.

Delight in the picturesque silhouette of Rovinj characterized by high houses, narrow paved streets and small squares.

07 Between the Karst Edge and the Adriatic Sea is the Slovenia Istria. A land of pleasant climate and hospitable people. Enjoy its incredible taste with a pinch of fleur de sel and a splash of locally produced olive oil.

Discover the tradition of salt panning, a seven-hundred-year-old tradition producing high quality salt in a primal crystal form.

Enjoy a retreat at the hotel's spa to sooth the muscles after a week of travelling.
