**01** Your 7-day South Korean adventure begins as you arrive at Singapore Changi Airport for a seamless check-in and comfortable start to your journey.

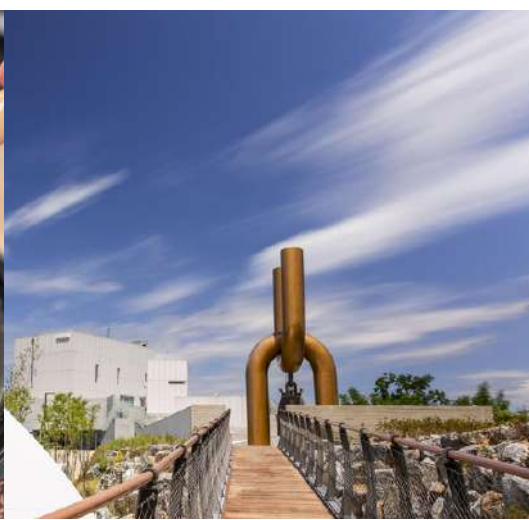
DAY INCHEON - GYEONGGI
