Whale Watching @ Augusta* (Valid from May-August) - Go on the whale watch cruise where the guide onboard would inspire you on the incredible history and the life of the humpback whale. There is also live stream underwater footage of our close encounters which you can enjoy from the comfort of your seat

*In the event if Whale watching season is not available, it will be replaced by the Cape Leeuwin Lighthouse

Cape Leeuwin Lighthouse*- This historic lighthouse is situated at the most south-westerly point of Australia, at the tip of a spectacular peninsula - where the Southern and Indian Oceans meet (This attraction will be replaced to whale watch if it's in season)

Jewel Cave - Set among the towering Karri forests of Augusta, Jewel is the largest show cave in Western Australia and home to one of the longest straw stalactites in Australia. Jewel Cave is an extremely well decorated cave, containing many beautiful examples of delicate helectites, cave coral, pendulites, a very large stalagmite called 'The Karri Forest', and beautiful examples of flowstone such as 'The Frozen Waterfall' and 'the Organ-pipes'.

Nougat & Wine Experience at Bettenays - Indulge in 5 premium wine which is perfectly matched with 5 different nougat varieties

Providore Margaret River - Combines vineyards, olive groves, organic vegetable gardens and gourmet food from the region. Located on a working farm in the heart of Wilyabrup, the stunning production and tasting centre provides visitors with an opportunity to stroll through kitchen gardens, watch products being made in the kitchens, sample wines, olive oils and fresh produce and then purchase from a huge selection of gourmet foods and gift items
