**DAY SINGAPORE - KANSAI**

01 Assemble at Changi Airport for our flight to Kansai, Osaka. Begin your long-awaited vacation.

02 Upon arrival, meet & greet by guide & transfer to Wakayama.

Senjojiki Rock Plateau - Over the millennia, waves of the Pacific Ocean have continually crashed into the Wakayama coastline, creating spectacular clusters of jagged rock formations.

Hashigui Iwa Rock - This mysterious, natural work of art, featuring a straight line of large and small unusually shaped rocks which stretches for around 850 meters, appears to be the stakes of a bridge.

Umeshu (plum wine) Making Experience - Enjoy making Umeshu fun and bring home.

Awa Odori Museum - The Awa Odori Kaikan is the perfect place to learn about and try one of Japan's most famous traditional dances. The dance, performed around Obon when the spirits of dead ancestors are honored, goes back about 400 years.

Kazurabashi Bridge - The bridge is one of the three Kazurabashi bridges in the Iya Valley, with the largest and most well-known one situated near the village of Nishi-Iya. It spans the Iya River and is an iconic symbol of the region.

Iya Valley - The secluded valley is characterized by steep mountain slopes and deep rocky gorges which were traditionally crossed by vine bridges.

Oboke and Koboke Gorge Cruise - A popular way to experience the beauty of these gorges is through the Oboke and Koboke Gorge Cruises. These boat tours take visitors along the Yoshino River, providing stunning views of the rugged cliffs, lush greenery, and unique rock formations that characterize the gorges.

Hirome Market - Is a great place to try a wide range of Kochi specialties, as you can buy food and drinks from different stalls and enjoy them at one of the many large tables set up around the market.

Ino Cho Paper Museum + Making Japanese Paper Experience - This museum displays the materials and tools used in traditional papermaking in Tosa, and explains the history and culture in an easy to understand manner. Enjoy making washi (Japanese paper) for yourself, creating a one-of-a-kind piece of paper.

Matsuyama Castle (included ropeway) - Offers a bird's-eye view of the area. And as one of 12 original castle keeps, it provides insights into the region as well as into the architecture and history of Japan.

Dogo Onsen Honkan (photo stop) - a symbol of Dogo Onsen which is said to be as Japan's oldest hot spring, is a facility exemplified by Kami-no-Yu. The most attractive feature is that, while it became the first public bathhouse in Japan designated as a National Important Cultural Property in 1994. The onsen that inspired the anime movie "Spirited Away"(千与千寻). Strolling around Dogo Onsen Town until the hotel check in.

Imabari Towel Museum - This is the world's first towel museum dedicated to the art of towel manufacturing. The unique museum has much to offer including displays of intricate traditional towels, works of art made from towels, an exhibition on the towel-making process, and there is even a garden area rich with seasonal beauty. *FREE 1x Imabari Towel

Kotohira Town - Is a small town located in the southwestern part of Kagawa. There are a lot of highlights with a long history and splendid cultures in Kotohira town, it is worth that you spend time going round the nostalgic mall and alleys leisurely.

Nakano Udon School (Making Udon) - Udon-making will be explained in detail by the Udon Teachers, starting with the kneading of the dough. The dough is then rolled out with the special rolling pin, boiled, and then enjoyed - all the steps are covered.
