DAY SINGAPORE - KILIMANJARO

01 **Tour fare excluding international airfare, need to buy separately.**

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport for your pleasant flight to Tanzania - Kilimanjaro.

DAY KILIMANJARO - TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK

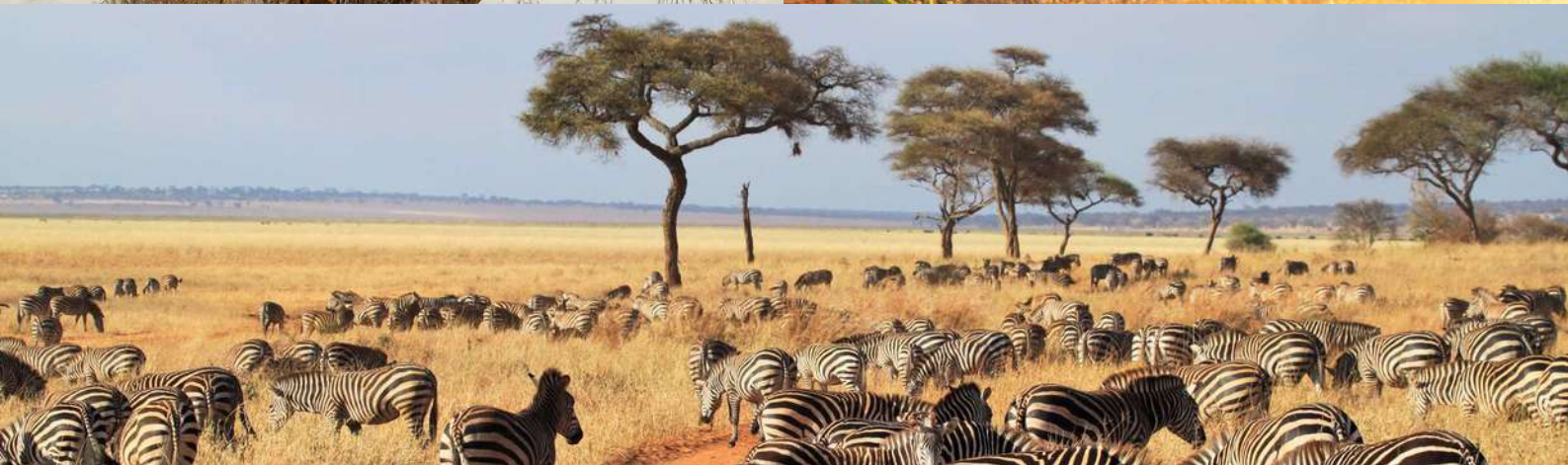
02 Welcome to Tanzania. Upon arrival, we will be met by our Tanzania representative.

Thereafter, depart for Tarangire National Park to arrive at your lodge for lunch. This afternoon we depart on an exciting game viewing drive in this area dotted with majestic baobab trees, stately eland antelopes among other games. Herds of up to 300 elephants scratch the dry Tarangire riverbed for underground streams, while migratory wildebeest, zebra, buffalo, impala, gazelle, hartebeest and eland crowd the shrinking lagoons. It's the greatest concentration of wildlife outside the Serengeti ecosystem - a smorgasbord for predators - and the one place in Tanzania where dry-country antelope such as the stately fringe-eared Oryx and peculiar long-necked gerenuk are regularly observed.

Return to the lodge for our dinner.

DAY TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK – NGORONGORO CONSERVATION AREA**03** This morning, after an early breakfast we will depart for Ngorongoro Conservation Area.

Arrive and have lunch at the lodge then we will descend the crater for an afternoon crater tour.

Ngorongoro Crater is the largest unbroken caldera in the world. It has been described as one of the great natural wonders of the world. Eight million years ago, the Ngorongoro Crater was an active volcano, but its cone collapsed, forming the crater that is 610 meters deep, 20 kilometres in diameter, and covers an area of 311 sq. km. Spectacular as it is, the crater accounts for just a tenth of the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. The crater is home to many species of wild game and birds. With the exception of impala and topi (due to fierce competition with the wildebeest) and the giraffe (because there is not much to eat at tree level), almost every species of African plains mammal lives in the crater, including the endangered black rhino, and the densest population of predators in Africa. A strange thing is that the crater elephants are mainly bulls! The birdlife, which includes the flamingo, is mainly seasonal, and is also affected by the ratio of soda to fresh water in Lake Magadi on the crater floor.

After our adventure, we will proceed back to our lodge.

DAY NGORONGORO CONSERVATION AREA**04** After an early breakfast, we will once again descend some 600 metres into the crater, which is home to an abundance of wildlife and a photogenic paradise for a full day of game-viewing drive.

Enjoy a picnic lunch at a scenic site.

In the late afternoon, return to the lodge for dinner and the night.

DAY NGORONGORO CONSERVATION AREA – SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

05 Enjoy a hearty breakfast at the lodge.
Before we check out, we will pick up our lunches boxes and leave for the world-famous Serengeti Plains.

Drive via Olduvai gorge. Olduvai Gorge is where hominid footprints believed to be 3.6million years old were found. We will enjoy an on-site talk on the interpretation of the gorge by the resident guide then proceed to Serengeti.

Picnic lunch will be served at a convenient location along the way.

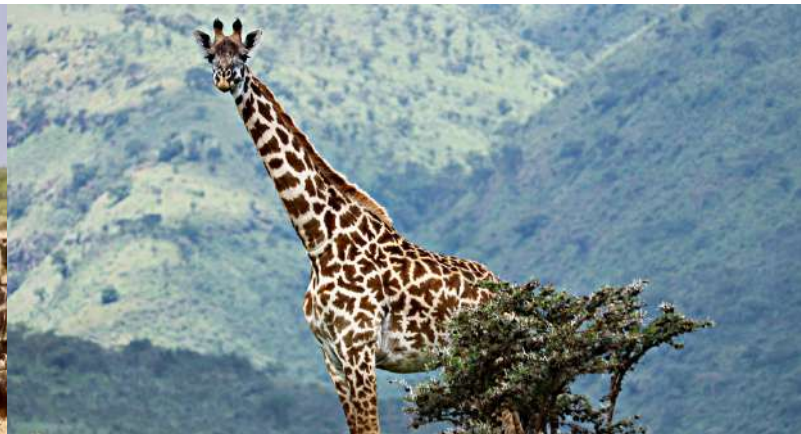
After our picnic lunch, we will continue our journey to Serengeti National Park.

In the late afternoon, we will go for game drive in search of the Big Five taking advantage of the heightened activity of the animals in the evenings.

The Serengeti National Park is the oldest National Park in Tanzania and has a population of approximately 25,000 large animals, largely ungulates along with reputedly the highest density of mammalian predators in Africa, lives in the crater. Large animals in the crater include the black rhinoceros, hippopotamus, wildebeest, zebra, eland and Thompson's gazelles.

Check in at the camp/lodge for our dinner and the night.

**DAY** SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

06 Enjoy a full day in the Serengeti with morning and afternoon game drives. Millions of plains game – wildebeests, zebra and impala feed and breed in the thousands in readiness for the annual migration north to the Mara ecosystem.

Visit the hippo pools where hundreds of big and small lazy hippopotamus soaks and nap in the afternoon sun.

Return to the camp for dinner and the night.

Meals: Breakfast, Picnic Lunch, Dinner
Optional Activities: Balloon Safari over the Serengeti Plains

DAY SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK - MAASAI MARA GAME RESERVE (KENYA)

07 Breakfast at the lodge then transfer to the Airstrip for your scheduled flight to Masai Mara Estimated Time of Departure 0815 hours (**Note: There is NO direct flight to Masai Marai, you will need to take flight from Seronera - Tarime. Take a road transfer to the border for Immigrations then proceed to Migori Airstrip where you will take another flight from Migori to Ol-Kiombo Airstrip).**

On arrival, our Kenya guide and driver will be meet you and transfer you to your lodge.

Lunch will be at the lodge and followed by our afternoon game drive.

The rolling plains and grasslands stretching far into the horizons as far as the eye can see is home to the black- manned lion, the savannah elephant, the Cape buffalo, wildebeests, the elusive leopard, cheetah, the spotted & stripped hyena, rhino, topi, Burchell's zebra, the Masai giraffe among many others. The Mara game reserve is one that can never disappoint. One is spoilt by the variety of bird and wildlife species in this game reserve. For a long time, Masai Mara Game Reserve has stubbed her authority as the 'granary' of wildlife in Kenya.

Dinner and Overnight at the lodge.

DAY MAASAI MARA

08 Enjoy a full day in Maasai Mara with morning and afternoon game drives in search of the 'big five'. These include the lion, savannah, elephants, the cape buffalo, the leopard and the black rhino.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Optional Activities: Balloon Safari over the Masai Mara

DAY MAASAI MARA

09 Enjoy another full day of morning and afternoon game safari and exciting bush adventure.

Visit a traditional Maasai Manyatta (off the beaten track) and experience the culture of this world-famous community. The Maasai people still live as they did for centuries. Interact with these nomadic people and experience their way of life as you learn about their customs and traditions.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner



DAY MAASAI MARA - LAKE ELEMENTEITA

10 After breakfast, depart for Lake Elementaita with game drive in Lake Nakuru National Park.

Lunch will be at Sarova Lion Hill Lodge.

This park provides sanctuary for Rothschild giraffe, black and white rhino and the elusive leopard. During the game drive, look out for both the black and white rhino, the endangered Rothschild Giraffe (Twiga), the elusive leopard as well as a host of other plains game and with a chance to visit the shores of the lake.

After the game drive, proceed to Lake Elementaita camp for dinner and the night.

**DAY LAKE ELEMENTEITA - NAIROBI - SINGAPORE**

11 After breakfast, bid farewell to the Africa savannah as we drive to the city of Nairobi.

Transfer to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport for your homebound flight
