DAY SINGAPORE - HANEDA - TOKYO

01 Assemble at Changi Airport for our flight to Haneda, Japan. Begin your long-awaited vacation.

Upon arrival, meet and greet by local guide and transfer to Tokyo.

- Meguro River - Meanders nearly 8 kilometers through several chic neighborhoods before emptying into Tokyo Bay. Is also one of Tokyo's premier cherry blossom viewing spots. Over a kilometer of trees lining the paths on either side of the river in Nakameguro burst into bloom at the end of March and beginning of April, forming a corridor of flower clouds above the river.

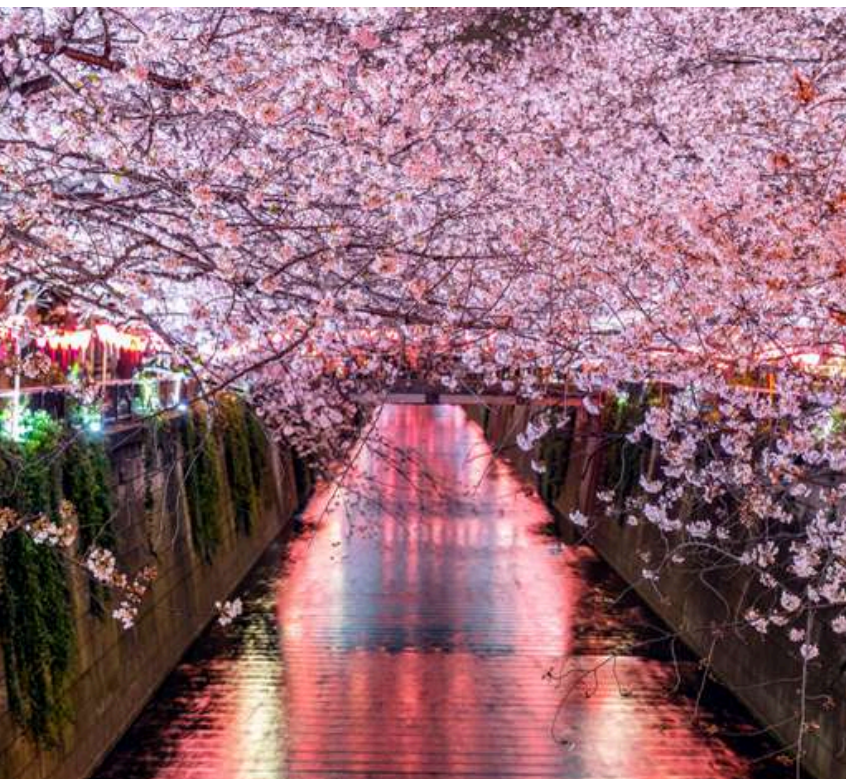
DAY TOKYO - IBARAKI

02 • Nakaminato Fish Market - Popular among locals and visitors alike, this fish market is known for its affordable prices and restaurants serving up local seafood.

- Kairakuen - Is ranked among Japan's top three most beautiful gardens, alongside Kenrokuen in Kanazawa and Korakuen in Okayama. The garden was established in 1842 by Nariaki Tokugawa, the ninth feudal lord of the Mito Domain. It has since served as a place of relaxation and recreation for the public. Cherry blossoms and azalea in the spring and Japanese bush clovers in autumn keep Kairakuen looking beautiful year-round.

- Besshunkan Museum of Plum Wine & Sake + Tasking - Is a museum where visitors can learn about and experience sake, operated by Meiri Sake Brewery, a sake brewery that has been in business since the Edo period.

DAY IBARAKI - TOCHIGI

- Oya History Museum-Subterranean Cave - The exhibition features the long history of the mining since the 17th century, with many materials on display. The underground cavern, covering 20,000 sq. metres, is large enough to fit a baseball field.

- Nikko Toshogu - It is known for its elaborate and ornate architectural design, intricate wood carvings, and its historical and cultural significance. The shrine complex consists of multiple buildings, gates, and sacred areas set within a peaceful forested area.

- Kegon Falls - Has been designated one of Japan's Three Most Beautiful Waterfalls. Water from Lake Chuzenji falls 97 metres straight down to the rocks below creating a dynamic and artistic work of nature.

- Strawberry Picking - Enjoy Strawberry picking fun.

- Abandoned Railway Walk - is a unique and intriguing destination for those interested in exploring historical and natural sites. Located in the mountainous region of Gunma Prefecture, this walk follows a decommissioned railway line that once connected various towns and industries in the area.

- Yubatake - Is the symbol of Kusatsu and one of the resort's main sources of hot spring water. In fact, with an output of 5000 liters per minute, the Yubatake ranks among Japan's single most productive hot spring sources.

DAY GUNMA - SAITAMA - TOKYO

- Gongendo Park - The sakura garden in Gongendo is a hot spot for cherry blossoms, thanks to the 1000 Yoshino cherry trees that line up along a stretch of 1 km. Surrounded by beautiful yellow rapeseed, this place is a popular destination for spring explorers.

- Kawagoe Kurazukuri Warehouse District - Provides a nostalgic scene from the Edo Period (1603-1867). The word "kura" means "warehouse" in Japanese, and Kurazukuri are clay-walled warehouse-styled buildings that are constructed with an Edo architectural flavor.

- Decoration Balloon DIY Experience - You can make your own original decoration balloons by filling balloons made of a special transparent material like glass with dried flowers, feathers, etc. and decorating them with stylish ribbons and flowers.

DAY TOKYO - KANAGAWA - TOKYO

- Kotokuin Temple - Home of the Daibutsu statue, aka the Great Buddha - the best known of Kamakura's attractions. The temple dates from 741, and the bronze statue of Buddha from 1252. Over 36 feet (11 metres) high and weighing 121 tonnes, the figure appears ungainly and top-heavy from a distance, but from close up the proportions seem perfect.

- Tsurugaoka Hachimangu - Is Kamakura's most important shrine. It was founded by Minamoto Yoriyoshi in 1063, and enlarged and moved to its current site in 1180 by Minamoto Yoritomo, the founder and first shogun of the Kamakura government.

- Mitsui Outlet Park Kisarazu - Is a prominent shopping destination located in Kisarazu City, Chiba Prefecture, Japan. It's part of the Mitsui Outlet Park chain, known for offering a wide range of brand-name goods at discounted prices.

- Ueno Park - Is a large public park next to Ueno Station in central Tokyo. Come and enjoy the extraordinary beauty of 800 Somei-yoshino cherry trees in full bloom
- Ameyoko Shopping Street - The bustling Ameyoko shopping street consists of two sections. Part of it is set like an open-air market, while the Ameyoko plaza is directly beneath the JR train tracks. The shopping street is an ideal place to buy souvenirs, see vendors hawking their wares, and sample some of Tokyo's cheapest, rustic eats at the seafood restaurants or various shops offering foods from a diverse range of cultures.
- Shinjuku Gyoen National Garden - Shinjuku Gyoen combines three distinct types of gardens - Japanese traditional, formal and landscape with sprawling lawns and other natural landscaping. In the spring you can admire 900 cherry trees that tinge the park pink with their delicate blooms.

- Asakusa - An area centered around Sensoji Temple with Kaminarimon ("Thunder Gate") and Nakamise shopping street - is surrounded by water and immersed in rich tradition. Take in riverside views, or stroll the traditional streets filled with stalls and authentic souvenir shops selling quintessential Japanese goods.
